Educational Timeline

- School year: September or October to June; Graduation occurs in June
- Primary school is eight years followed by four years of secondary school

Group A: Documents That Meet High School Graduation Requirement

Students presenting documents other than those listed below will be evaluated on a case-by-case basis

<i>Svjedodžba o Završnom Ispitu</i>	Certificate of Final Examination
- Document must include or accompany report of all final grades	
<i>Svjedodžba o Završenom Srednjem Obrazovanju</i>	Certificate of Completion of Secondary Education
- Document must include or accompany report of all final grades	
<i>Svjedodžba Maturi</i>	Maturity Certificate
- Document must include or accompany report of all final grades	
<i>Svjedodžba o Završnome Radu</i>	Certificate of Final Work
- Document must include or accompany report of all final grades	

Group B: Documents That Do Not Meet High School Graduation Requirement

Comparable to less than completion of US high school

<i>Svjedodžba (from osnovna škola)</i>	Certificate (from Basic School)
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GPA Calculation

Calculate the cumulative high school GPA by converting line-by-line all final exam grades listed on the "Group A" document above, weighing each value equally. Convert to US equivalents and then to quality points. Divide quality points by the total number of exams attempted.

Class Ranking

Class rank is evaluated based on a letter written and submitted by the headmaster or principal of the institution from which the student graduated. The letter must confirm both the student's final position in the student's secondary school class and the total number of students in the graduating class (e.g. the student is 41st in a total graduating class of 112 students).

Post-Secondary Education

Students will be charged terms of attendance and considered transfer students if they have enrolled as a regular student and attended one or more courses at any of the types of institutions listed below (may not be all inclusive) or any other institution that requires proof of high school graduation as a pre-requisite for admission (subject to review on a case-by-case basis).
